

# WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS REPORT FEBRUARY 28, 2020

### **City Manager**

• Mural at Veterans Park – The Punta Gorda Mural Society is seeking City Council permission to install a mural on the designated eight foot tall mural wall located in Veterans Park. The proposed mural is to be a recreation of the "Historic Punta Gorda Army Airfield" (PGAAF) mural, which once adorned a building at the Punta Gorda Airport. The PGAAF mural as originally designed commemorates the development and use of the Army Airfield during World War II. The Airfield was originally constructed in 1943. It was used by the US Army Air Corps to train pilots in flying P-40 and P-51 fighter aircraft. It is



- estimated that 750 pilots received training at Punta Gorda from 1943 to 1945.

- Wings Over Charlotte Harbor City Council will review an event permit for Wings Over Charlotte Harbor to be held Oct. 23, 24, & 25 at their upcoming meeting. The main viewing area for the event will be at Fishermen's Village. There will be a food truck rally and spectator viewing at Gilchrist Park. Other viewing areas requested are Alice, Shreve, Pittman & Brown Parks. The applicant is also requesting to close W. Retta Esplanade from Harvey Street to the tidal creek bridge and working to secure off-site parking locations along with shuttle services to the viewing areas.
- Signs in the Right of Way City Council will have a discussion about signs at the Mar. 4 meeting. Due to an abundance of signs in the Right of Way, staff began working weekends when sign infractions seem to be at their most prolific. Due to the numerous violations, the Code Enforcement Board, Feb. 26, heard approximately 16 cases related to signs in the Right of Way. The Code Board motioned to find the Respondent(s) violated Chapter 11.6 Prohibited Signs and Devices (c) and further ORDERED the Respondent(s) to pay case costs in most cases a \$100.00 fine.
- **Institute for Elected Municipal Officials** Congratulations are in order for Councilmember John Miller for his completion of the Institute for Elected Municipal Officials. The primary objective of the Florida League of Cities program is to provide elected municipal officials with an intensive academic program that will assist them in effectively meeting the requirements of their elected role. The program offered a comprehensive overview of Florida municipal government.

- Madrid Sidewalk Construction Excavation, pipe placement and compaction of subbase continues. Sidewalk base prep, formwork and concrete placement is occurring. Pending is the delivery and installation of the catch basins. The work area is from the western drive of the Burnt Store Publix Plaza to US 41 SB. This project is scheduled to complete by the end of May 2020. - Sailfish Bridge Construction Sailfish Bridge Update Change in Schedule There will be no work on Sailfish Bridge Friday, Feb. 28. The bridge will be fully open to boat traffic. On Mar. 2, the work under Sailfish Bridge will continue at the normal schedule of 7 a.m. until 6 p.m. with passage allowed at 9 a.m., noon and 3 p.m. On Mar. 3 Sailfish Bridge will be completely closed to boat traffic from 9:15 a.m. until 6 p.m. while




- concrete grout is being placed under the bridge. Once the concrete grout pour is started at 9:15 am, there can be no boat passage until 6 p.m. that evening as the concrete pour must be a continuous operation. There will be no noon or 3 p.m. passage allowed on Mar. 3. This is the final stage of the bridge repair. Beginning Mar. 4, the bridge will be fully open to boat traffic. Short momentary delays may occur at later dates as cleanup and inspections are completed. Please contact Mark Gering, City Engineer, at 941-575-5030 for more information.
- **ADA Interior Signage and Wayfinding -** The signs for the Public Works and Utilities Campus are being manufactured. Installation is anticipated to commence the beginning of March.
- Alligator Creek pedestrian bridge along US 41 NB-FDOT Right of Way The project is construction complete with exception of the power supply to be scheduled with FPL to service the decorative light fixtures and poles. The pedestrian bridge is open for public use.

- City wide Drainage Swale regrading To date JRL Underground has completed work at 662 properties totaling 492,100 square feet of grading/sodding. Work areas during the week of Feb. 24 include 425-441 Valletta Ct. Mar. 1 work areas include 4000-4011 Castellanos and locations along Trieste Dr.
- Veterans Park Phase II The project is near substantial completion, the contractor still has to install the handrails around the gazebo and ramps. The anticipated manufacturing completion date for handrails is Mar. 3 and installation of handrails should be completed by Mar. 11. Staff will be developing a punchlist inspection report during the week of Mar. 2.

#### **Canal Maintenance**

- **Ponce Inlet Dredging** Project complete.
- Seawall Assessment Program Project complete.
- **Seawall Replacement Projects** The seawall replacement contractor has completed eight seawall replacement projects. There are three projects under construction in PGI and three under construction in BSI. A seawall replacement project is not considered complete until the sod has been placed.
  - > Crews filled depressions at 14 locations.
  - > Crews performed five seawall cap and seam patches (61' linear ft.).

The dredging and placement of rip-rap along the mangrove planting areas continues. Boaters NEED to stay out of the new pass until construction is completed which is scheduled to occur in April. DO NOT open the turbidity curtains to gain access through the pass. Damage to vessel propulsion systems is very likely to occur if they enter the pass. The canals between Almar Drive and River Bay Drive and Sea Edge Drive may be closed to through traffic during construction operations. Boaters should use caution when operating near the construction area. Trucking of dredge spoils from Casey Key Drive to the Colony Point Drive spoil site continues. Residents NEED to stay out of the Colony Point Drive spoil site and off of the spoil piles. Heavy equipment is being used in the area and injury is likely to occur.
