Congratulations to John Smith (Smitty) celebrating 20 years with the City of Punta Gorda.

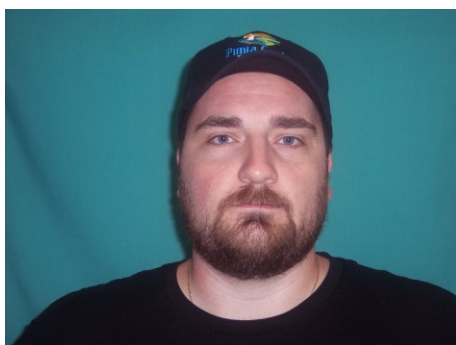

Training offerings

IT maintains a training tool called SkillSets Online to provide computer-based training on a wide variety of IT and Non-IT topics. To use this tool requires signing out a “Library Card” to gain access to the classes which can be used for two weeks to take any trainings. The card can then be renewed as necessary if courses take longer. This request should be sent to your supervisor who will then contact IT through a SkyNet ticket to approve the access.
