

Hurricane Charley

Hurricane Charley strengthened rapidly just before suddenly changing track and making landfall on the southwestern coast of Florida on August 13, 2004.



As a Category 4, it was the strongest hurricane to hit Florida since Hurricane Andrew in 1992.









With sustained winds of over 150 mph, Charley destroyed nearly everything in its path.





WHAT IS AN ESTUARY?

- A body of water where fresh water mixes with sait water; water is called brackish.
- Water salt content varies throughout t estuary and throughout the year.
- May be called bay, sound or harbo

WHY ARE ESTUARIES IMPORTANT?



- Provide habitats that support marine food chains and wildling
- Supply hatching areas, feeding grounds and refuges for fish and other animals.
 Provide protection and act as a buffer from storms.
- Filter pollution from freshwater runoff before reaching the se
- Provide a playground for boating, fishing, swimming and wildlife viewing

THE CHARLOTTE HARBOR ESTUARIES:

 Have been recognized by Congress as an "estuary of national signific creation what is known as the Charlette Harbor National Setuary Pro-

 Are "preserved in essentially natural conditions for future generations to enjoy" by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection as aquatipreserves.



- Include 350 square miles from Venice to Bonita Springs.
- Are fed by the Myakka, Peace and Caloosahatchee rivers and 11 saltwater passes from the Gulf of Marina.

Provide an estimated \$4.7 billion per year in local income ()



Partnership Related Key Performance Measures

- City property tax bill is lower than unincorporated Charlotte County highly unusual.
- Ranking between 2 to 5 Lowest Index Crime Rate in State of Florida of 19 cities between 15,000 20,000 in population.
- Arts & Recreation related partnerships result in City not having to fund in-house or contract for recreation and cultural services.
- Community Logo & One Community/One Message partnership resulted in cost avoidance in range of over \$100,000.
- Parks and Recreation Master Plan partnership resulted in cost avoidance of \$75,000+/-.
