Are masks required in the City of Punta Gorda?

Face coverings are required in the City of Punta Gorda. In response to the public health emergency within the City of Punta Gorda resulting from the spread of COVID-19 face coverings are now required to be worn indoors. Additionally, all persons preparing or serving food or beverages for public consumption shall be required to wear a face covering. The fine for a first offense of this Ordinance shall be \$25.00; the fine for a second offense shall be \$100.00; and all additional offenses shall be \$250.00 per offense. City Code Inspectors and Law Enforcement Officers shall have the discretion to issue a written warning instead of a citation for the first offense.
