OLD YEAR 2021 AND NEW YEAR 2022

Important Date 10/15/2021, PO Rollover/Carryover submitted and all invoices for merchandise received or services completed by 09/30/2021, to finance by 10/15/2021 or before would be better.

All **BPO** will close on 10/18/2021, please if you have something you know you have not received an invoice for, request an invoice from your vendor, and process ASAP. If you need assistance getting invoices ask for our assistance.

Keep in mind that we will need documentation – shipping report, packing slip, and invoice - <u>signed and dated by city employee verifying the goods or services</u> were received prior to 9/30.



PROCUREMENT POINTERS:

Insurance & Hold Harmless

Do not approve any work and/or site visit, on City property or a project site, without Procurement's approval. The City cannot have anyone on site without a Hold Harmless form signed. Before we issue a purchase order we obtain and approve the Contractor's insurance, making sure coverage is adequate and the City is listed as the Certificate Holder.
