- >FY 2023 Gas Tax funds \$263,400
 - ➤ Anticipates Oct 2022 as gas tax holiday
 - ➤ If State provides municipalities with lost revenue, would increase estimate approximately \$23,000
- ➤ FY 2024-2027 Estimated increase 2% with full year
- FY 2023-2027 Balanced with subsidy from General Fund Ad Valorem of \$459,000 Punta Gorda

Six Cent Gas Tax Fund

- >FY 2023 Gas Tax revenue estimate \$587,500
 - ➤ Anticipates Oct 2022 as gas tax holiday
 - ➤ If State provides municipalities with lost revenue, would increase estimate approximately \$50,000
 - Estimated 2% growth each year FY 2024-2027.
- ➤ Other revenues per contracts

Six Cent Gas Tax Fund

- >FY 2023 expenditures per division request
 - ➤ Electric increase Jan 2022 approx. 18.1% which included a fuel increase; FPL projection showed that decreasing approximately 3.1% in FY 2023
 - ➤ Charlotte County notified City of upgrades to Bridge lights and change to LED; City's current estimate for City portion of Bridge lights is \$150,000 in FY 2023 only
 - Fuel increase estimated at current rates, may need adjustment if rates continue to climb
 - ➤ Administrative charges estimated at 3% increase but will be adjusted based on all updated budgets

Six Cent Gas Tax Fund

- ➤ FY 2024-2027 most expenditures 3% increase except street sweeping, sidewalk replacement, and storm sewers held flat
 - Fuel uses current rates with 3% increase. If rates return to a more normal level, the future years would be reduced and would help to balance FY 2027.
