Sanitation Fund

- ≻FY 2023 Balanced, with recommended increases
- Recycling has budgeted increase based on requested increase on contract (8.06%)
- ➢Fuel budgeted at estimated diesel rate of \$5.50 (120% increase from FY 2021)
- ➢Yardwaste disposal budgeted based on requested increase (8%)
- ► Landfill increase estimated at 3%

Sanitation Fund

- ➤Contractual Services for temporary labor increased \$25,000 to cover for vacations, sick, FMLA, injuries or employee turnover
- ➤Cost for commodities, such as tires, have seen increases of approximately 21% during the current year and expected to increase an additional 7.5%
- ➢ Increases in equipment costs, such as packers, estimated at 16% increase from prior year estimates

Sanitation Fund Challenges

- Attracting and retaining employees with CDL licenses
- ➢ Pay and classification study is under way but changes that may occur as a result are not included in proposed budget
- ➢ Fuel was reduced to \$4 estimate in FY 2024 and beyond, but it is very unpredictable at the moment what fuel rate will be in the future
- Economic predictions vary widely (recession vs reduction inflation increases)

Sanitation Fund Possible Considerations

- Move to Fully Automated Packers (could reduce # of employees)
 - Possibly start as a pilot program (1 packer)
 - Level of service would be decreased slightly in that employees would not be able to pick up bags or some furniture. Would require households to use cart only.
- City take over Recycling program
 - Would need a detailed analysis for City that includes many factors
 - This would be a future possibility; not feasible currently with staffing issues
