A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PUNTA GORDA, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE 1990 DOWNTOWN REDEVELOPMENT PLAN ("PLAN") PURSUANT TO SECTION 163.361(1), FLORIDA STATUTES, EXTENDING THE TIME CERTAIN FOR COMPLETION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY OF THE "PLAN"; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Punta Gorda, Florida, by Resolution No. 956-90, approved and adopted the 1990 Downtown Redevelopment Plan ("Plan") for the City of Punta Gorda; and

WHEREAS, the Community Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") of the City of Punta Gorda is a community redevelopment agency organized and existing as established by the City Council of the City of Punta Gorda, Resolution No. 955-89, and is vested with the responsibility for carrying out the Plan for the Community Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the "Agency" desires to extend the time limits on the establishment of loans, advances, and indebtedness, plan effectiveness and payment of indebtedness and receipt of tax increment to the maximum time limits allowed; and

WHEREAS, such extension of time limits modifies the "Plan's" implementation strategy to go through December 31, 2019, as described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PUNTA GORDA, FLORIDA, THAT:

- 1. The "Agency", acting as a Responsible Agency, has reviewed and considered the proposed modification to the "Plan" and recommends its approval to the City Council of the City of Punta Gorda; and.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 163.3194(2), Florida Statutes, the Planning Commission serving as the Local Planning Agency for the City of Punta Gorda, Florida has reviewed the "Plan", and has found said "Plan" to be consistent with the adopted Comprehensive Plan of the City of Punta Gorda, Florida; and and
- 3. A notice of public hearing was timely published in a newspaper of general circulation and notice to taxing authorities was timely mailed as provided in Section

163.346, Florida Statutes, and a public hearing has been held as required by Section 163.360(5), Florida Statues.

- 6. The City Council, pursuant to Section 163.361 (1), Florida Statues, modifies the 1990 Downtown Redevelopment Plan to extend the time limits on the establishment of loans, advances, and indebtedness, plan effectiveness and payment of indebtedness and receipt of tax increment through December 31, 2019.
 - 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
