Overview

- ▶ Identify Current & Future Needs
- ▶ Online Survey
 - ▶ 15 questions
 - ▶ Over 1,000 respondents
- ▶ Stakeholder Interviews
 - ▶ 14 discussion questions
 - ▶ 9 organizations interviewed
 - ▶ Representing over 1,200 members

Findings: Stakeholder Interviews

- ▶ Facilities Provide Opportunities
 - ▶ Fellowship
 - ▶ Exercise
 - ▶ Education & instruction
 - ▶ Boating access
- ▶ High Facility Utilization
 - ▶ Up to 7 activities per day
 - ▶ Up to 150 per large event
- ▶ Facilities generate little revenue



Findings: Stakeholder Interviews

- ▶ Facility Desires
 - ▶ An Alternative to PGICA
 - ▶ More Youth Opportunities
 - ▶ Family-Friendly Infrastructure
 - ▶ Enhance Waterfront Destination



Findings: Community Input

▶ Survey Statistics

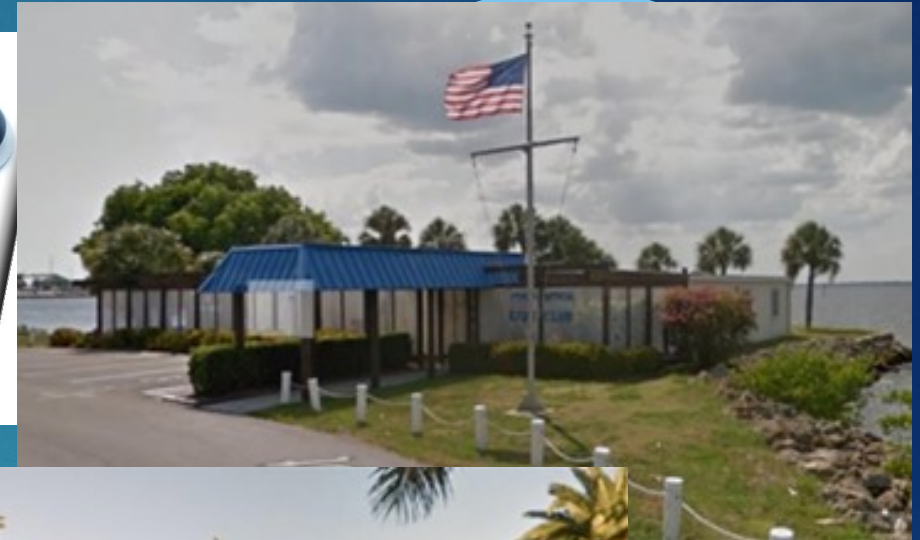
- ▶ Over 1,000 Respondents
- ▶ Over 800 Written Comments
- ▶ Respondent Demographics Reflect City
- ▶ Nearly 40% use Gilchrist Park once or more per week
- ▶ Over 50% did not belong to one of the current user organizations



Findings: Community Input

▶ Key Takeaways

- ▶ 66% Saw Benefit in a New Facility
- ▶ Mix of Activities Desired
 - ▶ Water related activities
 - ▶ Kayaking & canoeing
 - ▶ Picnic areas
 - ▶ Meeting Rooms
- ▶ Majority Opinion:
 - ▶ City should enhance its boater destination image



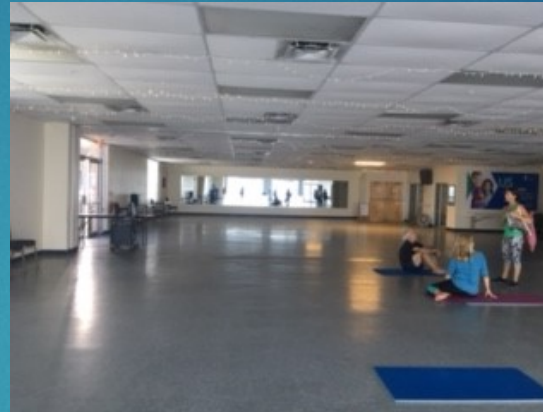
Emerging Themes

- ▶ Current Facility Needs Not Met
 - ▶ Substandard capacity & conditions
 - ▶ Limited Facility Access
- ▶ Possible support for a non-waterfront multi-use facility
- ▶ Expand water related activities
 - ▶ Paddle sports
 - ▶ Sailing
 - ▶ Advance Prior to Site Rebuild



Next Steps

- ▶ Reviewing the current water related infrastructure
 - ▶ break waters, channels, & dredged basins
 - ▶ Docks & Moorings Balls
- ▶ Form Focus Groups
- ▶ Identify Potential Public-Private Partnerships
- ▶ Relate Desired Activities to Facility Design
- ▶ Identify Infrastructure and Facility Costs
