FDOT Evaluates New I-75 Rest Areas

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District One is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study to identify sites for the placement of one northbound and one southbound rest area facility along Interstate 75. The study limits extend from the Charlotte/Lee County line north to the interchange of SR 681 and I-75 in Sarasota County. The new rest areas would replace the recently closed Jones Loop Rest Area located at Exit 161 in Charlotte County. Staff is evaluating five build alternative locations, three in the northbound direction of I-75, and two in the southbound direction of I-75. Each of the build alternatives will require additional right-of-way adjacent to I-75. FDOT does not anticipate residential or business relocations for any of the build alternatives. As part of this study, FDOT will consider a "no-build" alternative, which would not include a new rest area in this segment of I-75. At this time, the FDOT Five-Year Work Program does not include funding for the design, right-of-way acquisition, or construction phases for the rest area project.

Public Meeting Scheduled

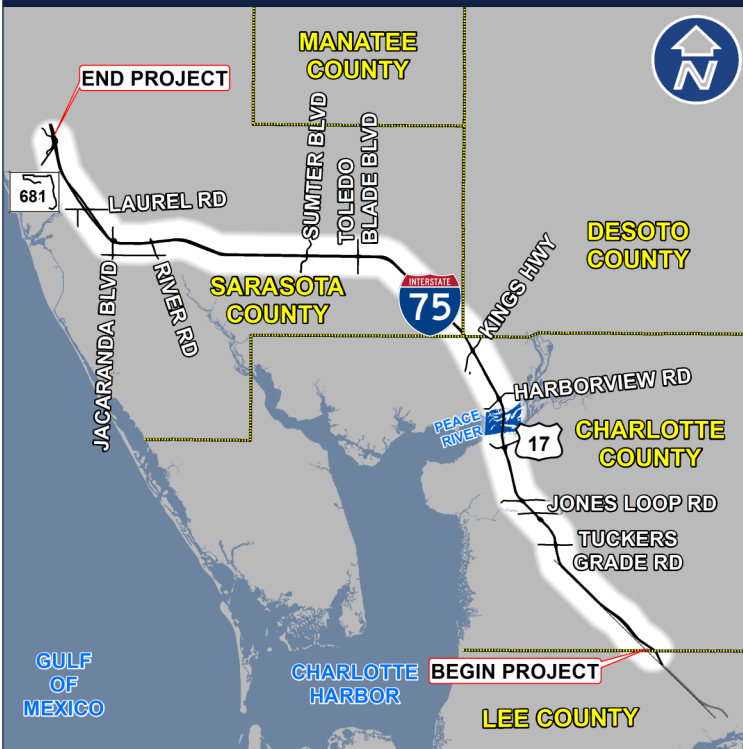
