

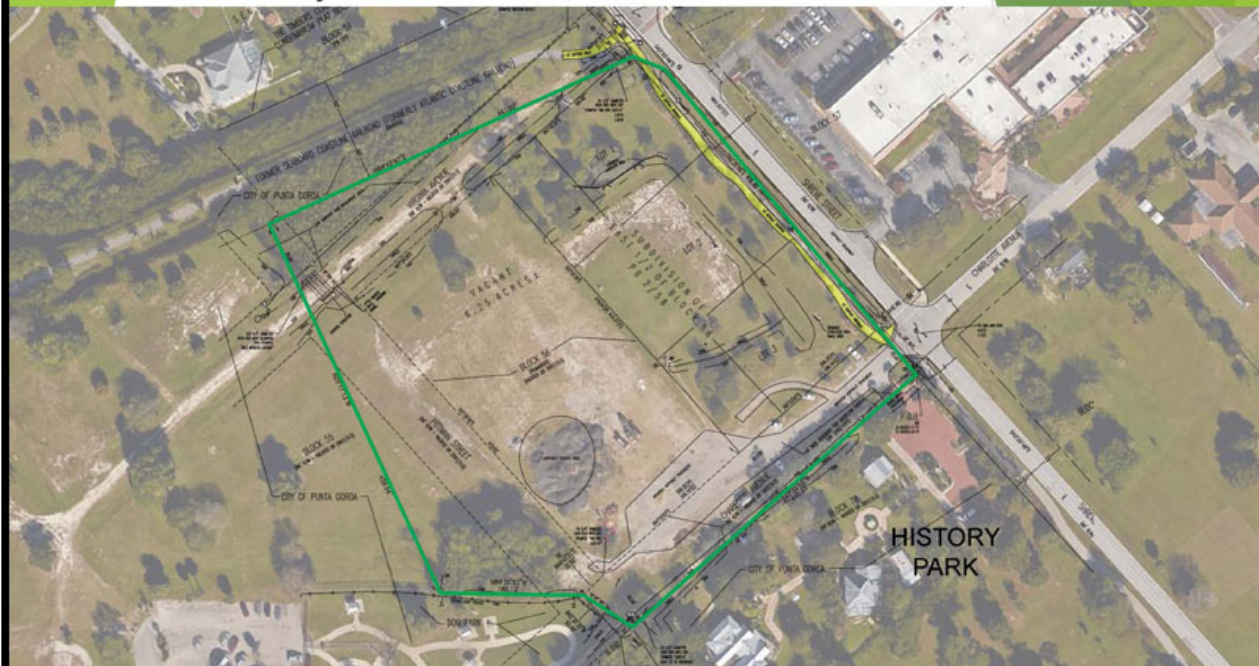

- Ample room between shelves & no books on the lowest shelves

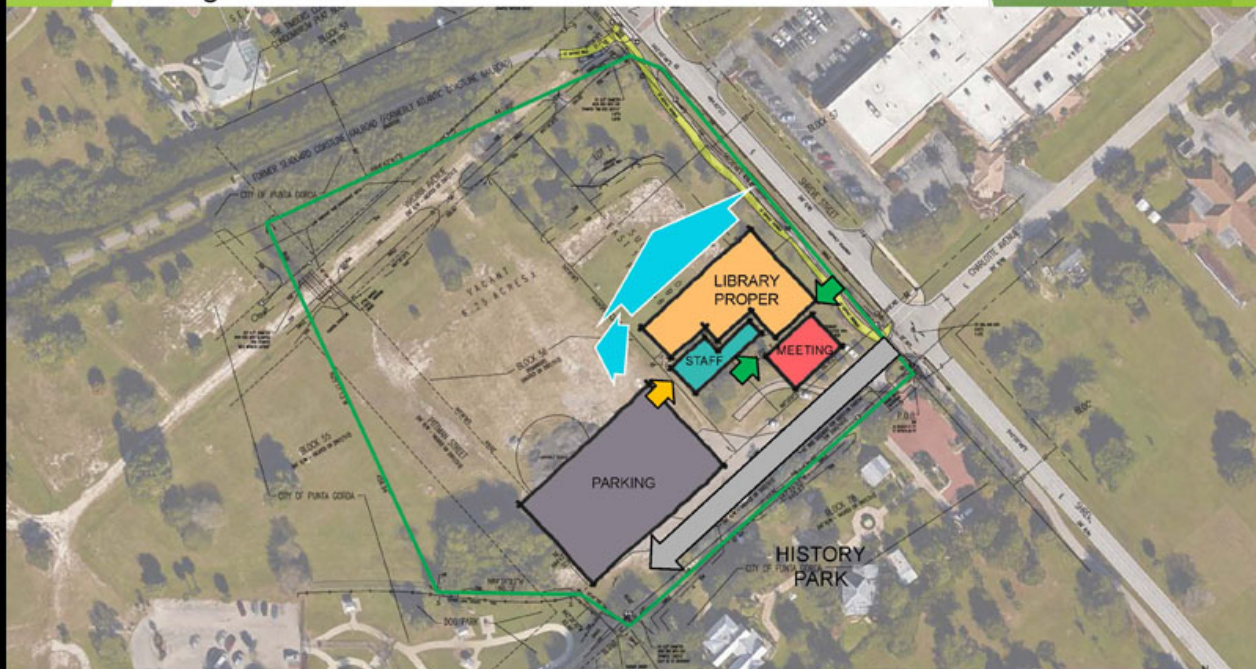
Limits of Project Site



Site Planning Design Challenges

- Building position on site
- Vehicular access for:
 - book drop
 - covered drop off for pedestrians
 - deliveries
 - service vehicles
- Walkways/paths for pedestrians to enter the building from west and east sides
- Overflow parking
- Pedestrian connection to the History Park

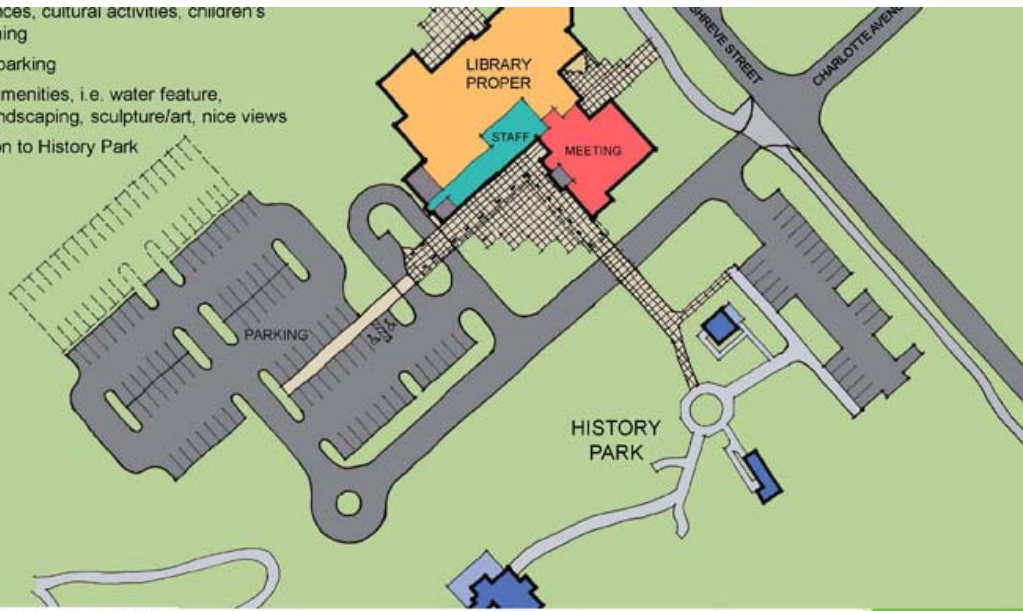
Schematic Site Plan

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Mission Revival Style

- Facades are stucco
- Arcaded porches are common
- Windows are often arched
- Roofs are traditionally barrel tile, with decorative parapets common
