The Punta Gorda Police Department is identifying the officer involved in the shoot/don't shoot scenario which took place on August 9, 2016, as Officer Lee Coel. Officer Coel was hired by the Punta Gorda Police Department on March 17, 2014.

Officer Coel is frequently seen throughout our community providing department presentations and tours and specifically role-playing in these shoot/don't shoot scenarios as well as a police presence at youth and neighborhood events.

Officer Coel remains on administrative leave while the investigation into this incident gathers more details into how this tragedy happened. Like the rest of our community, Officer Coel is devastated by what happened and is receiving assistance from our department and the Police Benevolent Association at this time.
