


Storm Summary for Tropical Depression Nine

Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at 8 AM EDT

(Output from Hurrevac, based on National Hurricane Center Forecast Advisory #11A)

Nine is currently a tropical depression, with maximum sustained winds of 35 mph (30 kts), moving north at 2 mph. The estimated minimum central pressure is 1001 mb.

Certain coastal locations are under Hurricane Watch and Tropical Storm Warning.



Wind Analysis for Charlotte, FL

(Based upon Tropical Depression NINE Advisory #11A)

Wind Probabilities

Venice, FL, the closest reporting location, has within the 5-day forecast period of this advisory, a 21% chance of at least tropical storm-force (34kt/39mph) winds.

Peak Wind*

No tropical storm winds are predicted for Charlotte, FL during the next 72 hours.

Wind Arrival and Duration*

No tropical storm winds are predicted for Charlotte, FL during the next 72 hours.

* These wind estimations are limited to the first 72 hours (3 days) following advisory issuance, and are subject to considerable forecast uncertainty and generalization, especially if the storm is distant. Maximum sustained winds (the highest surface wind maintained over a 1 minute period) are reported here. Wind gusts and winds at higher elevations will be greater.
