(13 free public side tie, 1 pump out dock, 4 slips for PGPD, CCSO, FWC & marina work boat)


- Including moorings, there are 19 liveaboards.

East Side Garden/Fresh Market

- Vacant land at 317 E. Virginia Ave. will be converted to a garden/fresh market.
- Contracts under review by Legal Department and Trabue Woods United Initiative; anticipate final documents to be submitted to Council on 1/4/17.

Harborwalk Projects

- Harborwalk West Area 1 (federally funded) agreement award on today's agenda for approval. Pre-construction meeting scheduled for 12/15/16.
- Gilchrist Park Playground Urban Design staff met with vendor to discuss initial needs for construction. Public Works Engineering staff to meet with vendor 12/15/16 to discuss demolition and site work.
