During the first scenario, participant Mary Knowlton was struck with a live round and was fatally injured. She was transported to Lee Memorial Hospital where she was pronounced dead.

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement personnel were requested and have taken command of the investigation.

On August 9, 2016 at approximately 7:30 pm I responded to the Punta Gorda Police Department for an officer involved shooting. Upon arriving at the police department I was briefed on the incident and directed to go to Lee Memorial Hospital in Fort Myers to collect the victim's clothing and any projectiles recovered from the victim. While enroute to the hospital I was contacted by Lt. Cochran who advised me the victim was deceased and to cease the collection of any evidence. I was also advised FDLE would be responding to the hospital and assist them with any needs.

Upon arriving at Lee Memorial Hospital I made contact with Officer Pribble who was present with the deceased in the trauma unit. I stood by and awaited the arrival of personnel from FDLE. Once personnel from FDLE arrived I briefed them on the situation and stood by until cleared from the hospital.

After clearing from Lee Memorial Hospital I responded back to Punta Gorda Police Department where I made contact with Victim Advocate Ed Furstein. I escorted Ed Furstein to the 1625 Montia Court to make contact with the spouse of the deceased. While enroute to the residence I was contacted by Officer Pribble who advised the spouse of the deceased wished not to speak with anyone or have any contact. I arrived at the residence and stood by while Ed Furstein placed a business card in the door of the residence. I then returned back to the police department.

On August 10, 2016 I assisted FDLE with a search of the Public Safety building parking lot for a spent round. In addition I was asked to identify any previous damage on police unit 70. The damage I observed to the vehicle was not pre-existing to my knowledge.

On August 9, 2016 Lt. Terry A. Cochran received a call at approximately 7:02 p.m. from Corporal Justin Davoult who stated a civilian participant had just been accidentally shot during a Punta Gorda Police Department training scenario by Officer Lee Coel and she was being flown to Lee Memorial Hospital in critical condition. Corporal Davoult advised all investigators were being requested to respond by Captain J. Woodard who was on scene.

Lt. Cochran began his response and contacted Assistant State Attorney Shannon Doolity to notify her office of the officer involved shooting. A.S.A. Doolity advised she had received a call from Chief Lewis and was responding along with two of her investigators.

Lt. Cochran spoke again with Corporal Davoult while in route. Corporal Davoult advised Chief Lewis was in the process of talking with F.D.L.E. for a crime scene response and possibly taking over the investigation. Lt. Cochran advised Corporal Davoult to have Detective M. Meddaugh respond to the Lee Memorial Hospital and secure any evidence that was with the victim such as clothing, personal items and other pertinent items located by treating physicians.

Lt. Cochran arrived on the scene at approximately 7:48 p.m. and was advised the victim, 73 year old Mary Knowlton had died from her wounds at approximately 7:25 p.m. Lt. Cochran was advised by Chief Lewis that F.D.L.E. was responding and would be conducting the criminal investigation. Lt. Cochran was advised the organization attending the citizen academy training was the Punta Gorda Chamber of Commerce.

Lt. Cochran contacted Detective Meddaugh who was arriving on scene at the Lee Memorial Hospital. Detective Meddaugh was advised of Mrs. Knowlton's death and instructed to preserve the body and all evidence there until he was relieved by F.D.L.E.

Lt. Cochran was advised Officer Coel had been taken to the patrol lieutenant's office where he was being monitored by captain Woodard and Officer J. Gonzalez. Lt Cochran observed the rear parking area where the incident occurred had been taped off as a crime scene with a smaller area around two police vehicles parked just outside of the garage building taped off separately and an expandable tent deployed between the two vehicles to protect the area from the severe rain and weather occurring at that time. Officer Kelvin Jiminez was securing the scene and maintaining the crime scene entry log. Near the patrol room door and within the crime scene was Officer Lee Coel's patrol vehicle.

Lt. Cochran was advised the remaining thirty-plus civilian witnesses who were present at the time of the incident were sequestered in the training room and being tended by Corporal Grim and Lt. Salsman.

Lt. Cochran met with A.S.A. Shannon Doolity in the C.I.S. office and was soon joined by her Assistant Chief Investigator J. Scott Purdy and Investigator Steven A. Scalici at approximately 8:10 p.m. A.S.A Doolity advised they would remain on scene to assist F.D.L.E. with any legal issues, warrants or investigative issues as long as

they were needed.

F.D.L.E. S.A.C. John Burk and S.S.A. Patrick Crough arrived at approximately 8:15 p.m. and met with Lt. Cochran and S.A.O personnel. S.S.A. Crough advised he had additional special agents responding along with Crime Scene Tech Lee Dewey.

Lt. Cochran advised all outside entities that any needed work space, equipment or assistance was available to them. FDLE requested the interview room cameras be turned off as they do not video record their statements.

As agents arrived they were given interview and office space. Lt. Cochran and Corporal Davoult provided logistic support rotating both civilian and police witnesses to them for recorded statements. The civilian witnesses interviewed were documented on the class roster provided by the Punta Gorda Chamber of Commerce. This roster was later scanned into the file.

Lt. Cochran requested Victim Advocate Ed Furstein make himself available at the police department to speak with any witnesses that were affected by the incident.

S.S.A. Crough identified the case agent as S.A. Gary Negrinelli who was present on scene.

Captain Jason Ciaschini retrieved the video data from the departments outside security cameras and provided a copy to F.D.L.E. investigators to view.

At the conclusion of interviews being conducted and the crime scene being released S.S.A. Crough advised that they were leaving for the night at approximately 2:25 a.m. and would return at 9:00 a.m. on August 10th to survey the immediate crime scene around the vehicles along with Officer Coels patrol vehicle in the day light.

Lt. Cochran and Lt. D. Lipker determined the crime scene would remain intact and manned until the following day when F.D.L.E. arrived. Lt. Lipker advised that he had provided S.A. Tissot with his digital camera at the time of his interview and had not received it back. He advised it contained photographs of the scene immediately after the shots were fired and while fire personnel were working on the victim.

At 9:00 a.m. on August 10th Lt. Cochran met with S.A. Negrinelli, C.S.T. Lee Dewey and S.A. Michael Ortiz at the police department. They requested additional personnel for a grid search of the areas near the police vehicles used in the scenario. They had determined four rounds were fired and three bullets were accounted for leaving one outstanding. Lt. Cochran employed the help of detectives and fire fighter personnel to assist. After several searches the bullet remained outstanding.

Lt. Cochran stood by as S.A. Negrinelli and S.A. Ortiz re-searched Lee Coel's patrol vehicle. Taken from the vehicle was an empty blue plastic gun box, two partial boxes of CCI Blazer wad cutters, three boxes of

Winchester 38 caliber blanks, one box of 380 caliber blanks and a silver revolver with no cylinder.

The items were seized by C.S.T. Dewey who stated he would forward a copy of the property receipt to Lt. Cochran later in the day.

S.A. Ortiz interviewed Detective Davoult as he had participated in the event but left prior to the scenario based training.

During the course of the search Officer Coel's protective vest and duty belt were removed from the vehicle and turned over to Lt. Salsman who placed them into the armory for safe keeping. This included his duty weapon and Taser. Lt. Salsman and Captain Nichols later removed the AR-15 from the rack and also placed it into the armory for safe keeping.

At the direction of S.A. Negrinelli the crime scene was dismantled and cleared.

The unmarked vehicle used in the scenario and officer Coel's patrol vehicle were placed in storage at the Cooper St. Complex and later sealed.

On August 11, 2016 S.A. Negrinelli requested victim advocate assistance for three witnesses they had interviewed the evening of the incident. they were Fred Sepanick, Deborah Malinoski and John Pryor.

Lt. Cochran provided the names to Advocate Ed Furstein who then made contact for additional counseling for them.

On August 11, 2016 Lt. Cochran turned over a 3TB portable hard drive to S.A. Tissot which contained all files available on Officer Coel at the police department as well as additional video data from the parking lot security cameras which showed the rear lot from approximately 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. S.A. Tissot returned Lt. Lipker's camera at that time.

Lt. Cochran submitted the camera into evidence.

Lt. Cochran, Captain Ciaschini and C.S.T. Dille removed the narcotics training aids currently checked out by officer Coel from his locker room locker and submitted them back into evidence.

On August 12, 2016 Lt. Cochran met with S.S.A. Crough and S.A. Negrinelli. They inquired as to source of the 38 caliber wad cutters found in Officer Coel's patrol vehicle. Lt. Cochran advised them that the wad cutters were not a type of round purchased by the police department. They were advised that there were no 38 caliber pistols issued as duty weapons. They inquired about the source of the blanks. Lt. Cochran advised them that even though the

blanks would be an item provided for k-9 training by the department to date no records have been found verifying they were purchased by the department. They were advised that captain Ciaschini had been searching records for ammo purchases but to date had not found any 38 caliber ammo that was purchased by the department. One petty cash receipt had been located regarding 223 caliber blanks for the honor guard. They inquired as to who supervised Officer Coel. Lt. Cochran advised Captain Woodard at the present time and a short time ago Lt. Katie Heck. They requested to speak with them. Lt. Cochran introduced them to Lt. Heck but advised them Captain Woodard was not working at that time.

Lt. Cochran requested Property Tech Amber Dille research her requisitions for any that Lee Coel had submitted requesting blanks. She located one from February of 2016 he submitted for three boxes of 38 caliber blanks. These were approved by his supervisor at the time Lt. Katie Heck. Three boxes of Winchester 38 cal blanks were purchased on February 23, 2016 at Higher Power Outfitters. This information was provided to S.A. Gary Negrinelli.

On August 15, 2016 Lt. Cochran received information from the morning staff briefing. The information suggested that Officer Coel had been a regular customer at Higher Power Outfitters in Punta Gorda and possibly bought ammunition at that location from Ryan Ingle, the owner. Mr. Ingle had stated this to an unknown deputy with the CCSO. This information was provided to S.A Gary Negrinelli with FDLE.

Lt. Cochran met with S.S.A. Patrick Crough and S.A. Gary Negrinelli at the police department in CIS. The agents requested to speak with Lieutenant Heck and Captain Woodard for clarification purposes. Lt. Cochran provided the office space and both interviews were completed.

Lt. Cochran received a call from S.A. Negrinelli who requested aditional video from the departments outside security cameras. S.A. Negrinelli advised he would return the 3TB Seagate backup drive for the purpose of obtaining the video data. The drive was delivered and additional video data was transferred to it by Captain Ciaschini. The backup drive was returned to S.A. Negrinelli on August 22, 2016 by Lt. Cochran.

On August 8, 2016 Lt. Cochran made contact with S.A. Negrinelli and advised him that a sweat shirt worn by Officer Coel during the demonstration incident was still in the PGPD property room. He advised S.A. Ortiz would pick up the property on September 9, 2016.

On September 9, 2016 the sweat shirt was turned over to S.A. Ortiz.

On or about October 17, 2016 Lt. Cochran spoke with S.A. Negrinelli in reference to his office turning over their report to the SAO. He advised it had been turned over and no copy would be provided to PGPD prior to the SAO completing their review. He stated it was considered still active by the SAO. He further requested Lt. Cochran search the phone recordings for the month of June and see if a call between Officer Coel and Dispatcher Able

could be found on a daytime shift where Officer Coel advises her that he will be at the speedway testing blanks.

Lt. Cochran searched Officer Coels departmental phone records and schedule. Several calls to the station were identified and listened to but none matched the description of the conversation described by S.A. Negrinelli.

Lt. Cochran requested Dispatch Supervisor Audrey Dennis continue to try and search for the phone call. Her results to date were negative.

On October 26, 2016 Lt. Cochran spoke with Dispatcher Able and inquired if she remembered a phone call as described by Officer Coel. She stated she did not..

On October 26, 2016 Lt. Cochran contacted S.A. Negrinelli to advise him the call had not been located and Dispatcher Able did not remember it.

On October 27 he provided additional information that indicated the call could be between July 4th and July 26th and might have been made from his personal phone. He also requested the building video data be checked to see if data existed from that same period of time.

Lt. Cochran spoke with Captain Ciaschini who checked the video data for the building and detemined the earliest available recording was on or about August 30, 2016.

Lt. Cochran researched Officer Coel's schedule and found he worked 8 daytime shifts during that period of time. These days were provided to Dispather Supervisor Dennis for research.

Lt. Cochran spoke with S.A. Negrinelli on October 31, 2016 at which time he gave a date and time of a phone call from Officer Coel's personal phone to communications on June 30, 2016 at 10:27 a.m. He advised this was provided by his attorney from his phone bill.

The call was located but did not refer to anything about the speedway. It was regarding a call for service reference a turtle.

Lt. Cochran provided this information to S.A. Negrinelli on November 4, 2016.

On December 22, 2016 Lt. Cochran was made aware of a memeo from the State Attorney's office to Chief Lewis advising that they no longer required us to hold the police k-9 vehicle or any equipment with in. It was decided the vehicle would be inventoried and cleaned in preparation for the next k-9 officer touse it. Lt. Cochran was made aware that Corporal Heck and Officer Dean were cleaning out the vehicle and inventoring the property within when they came across an AR-15 extended 45 round magazine in the front console of the k-9 truck. The magazine was

collected and turned over to Detective Corporal Davoult who later turned it over to Lt. Cochran. The magazine had 39 rounds of range ammo stored in it but had been emptied into a second bag prior to Officer Dean providing it to Corporal Davoult.

The policy regarding rifle ammunition and accessories was reviewed and it did not appear to be a violation of policy for the extended magazine or rounds to be in the k-9 vehicle. The magazine and practice rounds were placed into the armory vault for safe keeping next to Officer Coels rifle and additional magazine.

On December 28, 2016 Lt. Cochran spoke with S.A. Negrinelli. S.A. Negrinelli requested that the calls by Officer Coel refrenced in the earlier information provided to him be re-examined and copies of the calls be provided to him at the request of the S.A.O.

On January 5, 2017 Lt. Cochran emailed the requested information along with the audio clips to A.S.A. Negrinelli.

On August 9, 2016, Detective Davoult was contacted by Captain Woodard who requested that I contact Detective Meddaugh and Lieutenant Cochran and for all to respond for a shooting investigation.

Upon arrival, Detective Davoult made contact with Captain Woodard who advised that a female involved in the Citizen Academy was struck by a projectile and she was transported to Lee Memorial for her injuries. Detective Davoult was requested to standby with Lieutenant Heck's department phone and await contact from the media and advise them that a media release was forthcoming. No phone calls were received during this time.

Detective Davoult sat with Officer Coel and Officer Gonzalez for a short period of time, awaiting instructions. Detective Davoult had relieved Captain Woodard at this time. Moments later, Captain Woodard returned and relieved Detective Davoult of this assignment.

Detective Davoult assisted in relaying witnesses from the training room at the police department to FDLE Agents located in CIS conducting interviews. At the completion of this assignment, Detective Davoult transported a female witness identified as Christine from the police department to a residence on Rock Creek.

On August 10, 2016, Detective Davoult assisted in a line search of the crime scene with FDLE Agents and Crime Scene Technicians. The item being sought after was a missing spent round that was fired and was believed to be in the parking lot. The spent round was not located at this time. On this same date, Detective Davoult provided a sworn recorded statement to Special Agent Michael Ortiz at the police department. [08/15/2016 14:48, JDAVOULT, 88, PGPD]
