9 AD: Today's date is August 9th, 2016; uh, the time now is
10 approximately 10:08 p.m. Myself, Special Agent
11 Alberto Diaz, with the Florida Department of Law
12 Enforcement. I'm currently at the Punta Gorda Fire
13 Department, Station 1, at 1410 Tamiami Trail, in
14 Punta Gorda. I'm inside room, uh, Fire Prevention
15 office, um, and I'll be speaking with Mr. Michael
16 Wade Keeney. All right. Mr. Keeney, if you could
17 please, state your date of birth.

18 MK: January 9th, 1989.

19 AD: Okay. And, um, before we begin, just, I have to
20 swear you in, and just in your own words, uh, what
21 is perjury?

22 MK: Uh, perjury is where you lie under oath.

23 AD: Okay. All right. So, if you could please raise your
24 right hand. Uh, do you swear and affirm the
25 statement you're about to give will be the truth,
26 the whole truth, and nothing but the truth?

1 MK: I do.

2 AD: Okay, that's fine. Thank you.

3 MK: All right.

4 AD: All right, um, if you could just please tell me
5 about what happened tonight; what you saw or heard,
6 did.

7 MK: Okay. Um, start at the beginning. Uh, we were
8 sitting in -- side the, uh, station. Um, I believe
9 it was one of the, uh, Punta Gorda police officers
10 came inside, said they had a man down in the parking
11 lot, uh, we really weren't sure what happened. Um, I
12 went to the Rescue, grabbed my gloves, uh, some my
13 medical equipment. We started going to the, uh, back
14 area of the parking lot near the, uh, the gym area.
15 Um, Punta --

16 AD: Did -- did you know who the officer was, or, by
17 name, or --

18 MK: I -- I'm not familiar with the, uh, with the
19 officers --

20 AD: Okay.

21 MK: -- here. Um, I don't know who it was.

22 AD: Okay.

23 MK: Um, I just know they were wearing a black uniform.

24 AD: Okay.

25 MK: I believe it was a black uniform.

1 AD: Okay.

2 MK: Um, so, I made my way to the back, um, there was
3 already -- we all found out at the same time, but, I
4 had to go back to my Rescue. Um, uh, couple of the
5 Punta Gorda Fire Department, uh, personnel were
6 already on scene. Um, still at this point, we
7 weren't -- there wasn't a clear picture as to what

10 that you -- you did, saw her -- what did -- what did

11 you see when you first went up to the scene, or,

12 after the officer came up to the fire station --

13 MK: Uh --

14 AD: -- what did you see, or --

15 MK: Um, I saw --

16 MK: Um I -- I had my -- my, uh, tablet with me that I

17 write my reports with, um --

18 AD: Okay.

19 MK: -- for documentation. Um, I set that down on a car.

20 Um, there was a revolver sitting on the car, um,

21 near where I put my computer. Um, and then we saw

22 like a blue, uh, gun laying on the ground, um, near

23 where the patient was.

24 AD: Okay.

25 MK: Um, feet were facing towards the gym, head was

1 facing towards the -- the station. So, I guess it --
2 that'd probably be like, uh, head was facing west.

3 AD: Okay.

4 MK: Um, like I said, uh, I -- I don't -- I really can't
5 remember if they were doing CPR before we got there,
6 but I think the city guys, uh, were.

7 AD: Who, the --

8 MK: The -- the Punta Gorda, uh, Fire Department.

9 AD: Was doing the CPR?

10 MK: I -- I believe so.

11 AD: Okay.

12 MK: Um, when I get my report wrote up -- I just still
13 need to talk to them about all that. But, uh -- uh,
14 yeah, she was laying on her back, um, supine. Um,
15 and then -- then we loaded her up, and did the --

16 AD: Okay.

17 MK: -- the treatments, en --

18 AD: Did she --

19 MK: -- route to the hospital.

20 AD: Did she say anything, do anything --

21 MK: [REDACTED]

22 AD: -- throughout that? Did she --

9 MK: Um, the lieutenant, um, Tyler, I forgot his last
10 name. Um, he rode in the Rescue with me, um, C.W.
11 McCloud, and the volunteer -- I forgot his name,
12 also, and then me. Um, my partner, Maxfield, was
13 driving the Rescue.

14 AD: Okay.

15 MK: Um, before we left, he was in the back just helping
16 us get set up, um, before we took off to the
17 hospital.

18 AD: Okay. All right. Um, did you hear anything there
19 that seem -- I mean, you said you -- you heard
20 different people around saying that she was stabbed,
21 or, it was different things were being said.

22 MK: Uh, not -- not stabbed. [REDACTED]

23 [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Um, one person said, uh --
24 again, I don't know who it was, there was a bunch of
25 people standing around --

1 AD: Yeah.

2 MK: -- us, um, because I was --

3 AD: What -- what -- what did you hear?

4 MK: I was trying to get a picture of what happened.

5 AD: What happened? Yeah.

6 MK: Um, one person said they were shooting, but they

7 were blanks, um, and they're like, And then this

8 happened after they were done shooting. Um, so they

9 were thinking maybe she had like a -- like passed

10 out or had a heart attack, or something, and then,

11 um, later on I heard her -- like somebody else come

12 back and they're like, "I think we shot her." And I

13 don't know who -- again, I don't -- I was focused on

14 the patient --

15 AD: Yeah.

16 MK: -- I was just hearing, um --

17 AD: Different things being said.

18 MK: Yeah.

19 AD: Okay.

6 ZM = Zachary Maxfield

7 AD: Today's date is August 9th, 2016. The time is
8 approximately 10:29 p.m. Myself, uh, Alberto Diaz,
9 Special Agent, Florida Department of Law
10 Enforcement. I'm currently at the Punta Gorda Fire
11 Department, Station One, located at 1410 Tamiami
12 Trail, Punta Gorda. I'm inside the Fire Prevention
13 Office. I'm with, um, Charlotte County and Fire --
14 Fire EMT, uh, Zachary Maxfield. All right. Mr.
15 Maxfield, if you could please, um, state -- what's
16 your date of birth?

17 ZM: 02/28/1988.

18 AD: Okay. Um, and for purposes of this, I have to swear
19 you in, but before we start, in your own words, what
20 is, uh, perjury?

21 ZM: Telling false statements under oath.

22 AD: Yeah. Okay. So if you could please raise your
23 right hand. Do you swear or affirm that the
24 statement you're about to give will be the truth,
25 the whole truth, and nothing but the truth?

26 ZM: Yes.

1 AD: Okay. Thank you. Appreciate it. Um, if you could
2 just tell me what happened tonight, what you heard,
3 saw, did -- what just happened, from beginning to
4 end?

5 ZM: Okay. Uh, uh, I was getting ready to go to the gym
6 out back. Uh, we were all sitting down on the sofas
7 watching a movie and, uh, all of a sudden the door
8 swung open. One of the Punta Gorda Police
9 Department employees said, "Let's go. There's a
10 woman down." Uh, we all jumped up, kind of in
11 shock, wondering if he was just joking around or
12 whatnot.

14 So we all ran outside, changed into my pants, uh,
15 grabbed the stretcher, uh, ran to the scene, um, got

7 AD: All right. What -- what did you see when you first

8 went up -- or do you remember who the police officer

9 was that came in -- in and said that

10 (unintelligible).

11 ZM: Um --

12 AD: Do you know the -- their name?

13 ZM: I believe his name is, uh, Calvin. I don't know his

14 last name.

15 AD: Okay.

16 ZM: I just -- I think his name was Calvin. I don't

17 really --

18 AD: Okay. What did you see when you went out there at

19 the scene? What did you see?

20 ZM: I saw a -- there was a ton of people around the

21 patient. So I barely saw the patient on the ground.

22 I saw, uh, two cop cars on each side of the patient.

23 I saw one officer, uh, applying direct pressure. [REDACTED]

25 [REDACTED] Um, there

1 was a couple other officers standing in the -- in
2 the area.

3

4 Um, on going to the scene, I saw some officers, uh,
5 kind of evacuating the -- the hot zone, uh, with the
6 other people who were there at the event. Um, and
7 like I said, once -- once I got the stretcher there,

8

9 and then I started running back to the rescue,
10 grabbed the rescue, pulled the rescue around, got a
11 backboard out. We backboarded her.

12

13 We loaded her up 'cause at -- by that time,
14 everything was done that -- on our end that needed
15 to be done and, [REDACTED]

19 AD: Okay. Um, and what did you do when you -- on your
20 guys' way there? What did you do?

21 ZM: Uh, I was the driver of the --

22 AD: Okay.

23 ZM: -- rescue.

24 AD: Okay. Um, beforehand, going back to what you saw,
25 um, [REDACTED]

1 ZM: [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

3 didn't know.
4 AD: Uh-huh.
5 ZM: I -- um, [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

15 was the volunteer, Charlotte County medic, Mike
16 Keeney [phonetic], um, Fire Medic for Punta Gorda
17 Tyler Canfield [phonetic], Fire Medic Punta Gorda,
18 uh, C.W. McCloud.
19 AD: Okay. And then, um, while you were there, did you
20 hear anything being said? Did you see -- did the
21 patient say anything?
22 ZM: No. The -- no. The patient did not say anything.
23 Um, it was just -- nothing was really said that --
24 besides what needs to be done. [REDACTED]

6 AD: What -- um, do you know what -- um, did you hear any

7 -- anyone saying anything there at the scene?

8 ZM: Uh, no. Out -- like I said, initially, when I was

9 there, I got the stretcher there and then I knew we

10 were gonna be transporting either to a landing zone

11 or to the hospital.

12 AD: Uh-huh.

13 ZM: So then I immediately, once -- [REDACTED]

14 [REDACTED] knew that there was

15 enough people there doing the -- the task at hand

16 that needed to be done, that the rescue was next in

17 line -- that we needed to get that rescue there and

18 we needed to load and go.

19 AD: Okay. Uh, so you went -- and --

20 ZM: So I wasn't at the -- initially, I was not at the

21 scene for more than, I'd say, 30 seconds.

22 AD: Okay.

23 ZM: And then I was back going to get the rescue and then

24 once I got the rescue to the scene again, um,

25 backboard out, we boarded, and we were in that

1 rescue within -- within minutes.

2 AD: Okay. It -- you helped load her into the --

3 ZM: Yes, sir.

4 AD: Okay. Did you -- um, when she -- when there at the

5 scene -- that you were there for the few seconds,

6 did you see anything around her --

7 ZM: I didn't --

8 AD: -- uh, anything --

9 ZM: I did not. I just --

10 AD: Okay.

11 ZM: -- just the -- about there's probably 8 to 10 people

12 in the -- the scene itself.

13 AD: Okay. All right.

14 ZM: Um, but --

15 AD: And --

16 ZM: -- not -- not even knowing which person was which --

17 AD: Okay.

18 ZM: -- it just got -- that's a quick estimate because --

19 AD: Okay.

20 ZM: -- it goes so fast.

21 AD: What -- uh, and then you drove to the hospital and

22 then what happened when you guys got to the

23 hospital?

24 ZM: Um, got to the hospital. Um, we got her out of the

25 rescue. We got her into the, uh, Lee Memorial

1 facility and then we transferred care to the Lee
2 Memorial ER staff.

3 AD: Okay. Um, you help -- you helped put her into the
4 hospital or move -- transfer her?

5 ZM: Yes, sir.

6 AD: Okay. Uh, do you -- do you remember who the doctor
7 was or -- okay.

8 ZM: No. There was -- uh, there was numerous staff in
9 the -- in the room.

10 AD: All right. Do you -- about how old was, uh, the
11 woman?

12 ZM: Uh, the woman who was --

13 AD: Injured.

14 ZM: -- injured?

15 AD: Yeah.

16 ZM: Uh, she was, I'd say, in her 70s.

17 AD: Okay.

18 ZM: I believe in her 70s.

19 AD: Okay. Uh, do you know her name -- remember her
20 name? Okay.

21 ZM: No.

22 AD: All right.

23 ZM: Don't know her name.

24 AD: Okay. Um, all right. Is there anything else that
25 I've missed or didn't cover with you that you can --

1 ZM: Uh-uh.

2 AD: -- tell me about? Okay.

3 ZM: No.

4 AD: All right. Well, this concludes the interview. The
5 time now is approximately 10:38 p.m.
