


Bicycle & Pedestrian Count Observation



City Staff along with the assistance of 14 volunteers from the community conducted bicycle and pedestrian counts at various locations throughout the City. Over the course of 38 total hours of observation at 10 locations 1,806 people were counted enjoying our City streets and trails for recreation and transportation. This data collection effort is part of the City's ongoing Complete Streets and Bicycle Friendly Community Initiatives.

This data collected over time will provide valuable information on how our community's investments in non-motorized transportation infrastructure are being used.
