## CITY OF PUNTA GORDA \*\*\* CLEANING UP STORM DEBRIS \*\*\*

Punta Gorda residents should follow these specific guidelines when disposing of severe storm or hurricane-related debris and household garbage to ensure that the City is eligible for FEMA Reimbursement.



## 1. HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE & RECYCLING

- Normal schedule
- Please have all trash out to the curb by 6AM on the day of collections
- 2. YARD WASTE
  - Palm fronds, Branches, Leaves, Shrubbery (shall not exceed 4" in diameter or 4' in length)
  - Do not mix with regular household trash and/or construction material
  - Please make sure it is true storm debris ONLY
- 3. CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION MATERIALS
  - Drywall, carpet, furniture, building debris, etc. if you have any of these items please place in a separate pile
  - Please make sure it is true storm debris ONLY

It is anticipated that cleanup work could begin as early as September 25<sup>th</sup>, pending FEMA approval

## PLEASE REMEMBER

- To ensure that the City is eligible for FEMA reimbursement, ALL vegetative debris must be placed in the right-of-way of YOUR property. The contractor will NOT collect anything placed on private property.
- MIXED materials will NOT be picked up.
- Avoid setting debris against trees, poles, mail boxes, fire hydrants, water meters, etc. Doing this makes it difficult for staff to pick up the materials and impede City services.
