

PUBLIC NOTICE

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLOTTE COUNTY, FLORIDA

Pursuant to Charlotte County Ordinance 2018 - 016, and upon the recommendation of the Fire Chief, the Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 2018-042 declaring a drought emergency and extreme risk of wild fires throughout Charlotte County, and imposed certain restrictions and prohibitions on open burning and discharge of fireworks. Given the recent rain events, and upon presentation and recommendation of the Fire Chief, the Board of County Commissioners has adopted a Resolution lifting the restrictions and prohibitions imposed and repealing Resolution 2018-042 in its entirety. The lifting of the ban took effect immediately upon Board approval on May 22, 2018.
