- B. Results of Court Order Regarding Lee Coel
- Mr. Lee Dehner, Board Attorney, announced Mr. Lee Coel had successfully appealed the Board's previous decision to not hear his disability claim, stating the Circuit Court had remanded the case back to the Board to render a decision based on the merits of the case. He reviewed the Board's discussions which led to their previous decision, as delineated in the minutes of their July 21, 2017, meeting, explaining the standards by which the Board must abide in any disability hearing. He recommended the Board move forward, announcing interrogatories would first be sent to the claimant along with medical releases for his signature.
- Mr. Kiburz requested an approximate timeframe.
- Mr. Dehner replied an initial hearing must be scheduled within 90 days of receipt of the interrogatories and signed medical releases, though an additional 90 days were allowable to complete independent medical examinations and discovery.
